

Staff-Student Liaison Committee (SSLC)

Each economics Staff-Student Liaison Committee (SSLC) exists to encourage students (a) to participate in making academic policy in the Department, (b) to comment on their learning experiences, and (c) to evaluate economics courses and teaching in ways that enhance the Department's provision.

There are two SSLCs, one for undergraduates and one for postgraduate students. Details are available in the Undergraduate Economics Handbook and the Postgraduate Economics Handbook, respectively.

Membership: Student Liaison Officer (undergraduate and postgraduate, respectively), Deputy Student Liaison Officer (undergraduate and postgraduate, respectively), student representatives elected from constituencies determined from time to time by Department meetings, and other students or members of staff co-opted with the approval of the Head of Department.

The SSLC reports to Department meetings (though at the HoD's discretion, matters may be raised for discussion at the TLC, UCC or GCC).
