

MBA Scholarship

Essex Business School is offering scholarships worth up to £6,000 to students funding their own MBA studies starting in October 2018.

The award will be offered in the form of a tuition fee discount of up to £6,000.

Terms and conditions

Who is eligible?

- The award is available to Home (UK), EU and overseas students who are entirely self-funded. It is not available to students who are fully or partly sponsored.
- Limited scholarships are available and students are considered for their eligibility on a first-come-first-served basis. We strongly advise you apply before 31 May 2018 to ensure you are considered for a scholarship.
- Only one scholarship award can be made per student and the award cannot normally be held in conjunction with other University of Essex scholarships including the Alumni Loyalty Discount.
- If you have been offered a scholarship but request to defer your entry, your scholarship offer will be reconsidered in line with the terms and conditions that apply in the new year of entry.
- The award is available to full-time MBA students and Executive Study students on a pro rata basis.

How do I apply?

You will be invited to interview as soon as possible after submitting your application. The MBA Director will assess you for a scholarship award during your interview.

We strongly encourage you to apply by 31st May 2018 in order to ensure you are considered for an award.

How do you decide if I will receive a scholarship?

During your interview, the MBA Director will be particularly looking for evidence of:

- Academic ability
- Professional experience and career progression
- Ideas on sustainable and entrepreneurial business
- Ability to communicate experience and ideas
- Plans for utilising the Essex MBA experience after the course

The University will also make use of official transcripts and certificates, submitted as part of your original application for admission to the course, to decide the level of your award. No alternative supporting evidence will be accepted. The MBA Scholarships Panel will oversee the allocation of awards.

How will I be notified?

You will be notified of the award in your initial offer letter.

How will the scholarship be paid?

The award will only be made available as a discount on the tuition fee that is payable on registration at the University.

Dispute resolution

Acceptance of the award constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions. In cases not covered by the above terms and conditions, or where a student claims exceptional circumstances, or disputes a decision not to make payments due under a scholarship, they should first put their case in writing to the Student Services Manager who will consider the circumstances and uphold, amend or revoke the original decision.
