

Wifi on campus

Eduroam

Our wifi on campus is **eduroam**, short for education roaming. It's free to use and is available pretty much everywhere except student accommodation.

To connect to eduroam, sign in with your Essex email address, for example re16495@essex.ac.uk, and your password.

File storage

M: Drive

Your M: Drive, also known as your home directory, gives you 1 GB of personal storage space. You can access it from any computer on campus by clicking My Documents.

Microsoft OneDrive

As part of your Microsoft Office 365 account, you get 1 TB of cloud storage space, which you can easily access off campus and on the move.

You can use OneDrive to share documents with other people at Essex – great for collaborating on a project.

To access your OneDrive account, sign in to Webmail and then choose the OneDrive icon from the top-left menu:
