This will be followed by talks about the applications of Mathematics and Statistics from Dr Tracy Robinson (Department of Psychology) and Dr Tom Scotto (Department of Government). Year 12 pupils will also receive advice about applying to University from our admissions team and have the opportunity to talk to a student panel about studying at University.

The day will close with the annual Winsten Lecture, which is being delivered by Joe Twyman, Director of Political and Social Research at You Gov.
